## Habitat for Humanity of Sarpy County

Habitat for Humanity of Sarpy County was formed in 1994.

There are 29 homes occupied by Sarpy Habitat families. These houses provide shelter for 38 adults and 85 children. We need your support to continue building homes in Sarpy County that families in need are able to afford. Please consider providing ongoing financial support to Sarpy Habitat by joining our Groundbreakers' Club.

### What is Habitat for Humanity?

Habitat for Humanity is a faith driven mission, committed to helping families in the United States and around the world find safe, decent, and affordable housing. Habitat homes are built by volunteers alongside Habitat families, known as Partner Families.

### Are Habitat for Humanity Homes a Giveaways?

Habitat homes are not given away. Partner Families must contribute 250-350 hours of work on their home and other Habitat projects, participate in homeownership education classes, and make mortgage payments.

The Partner Families buy their homes from Habitat by making no-interest, monthly mortgage payments. Included in the monthly payments are property taxes and homeowners insurance.

### What do the Habitat Homes Look Like?

Habitat homes are safe, decent houses that meet or exceed all local building codes.



The homes are built by the Partner Families with help from people who take pride in their volunteer work in the community, all under the direction of a professional builder.

### How are Partner Families Selected?

Families may apply during publicly announced application periods. All applications along with supporting documentation, including credit reports and references, are thoroughly reviewed. Following interviews of potential Partner Families, and visits to their current housing, the Selection Committee makes its' recommendations to the Board of Directors. The selection is based on level of

need, ability to pay a small monthly mortgage payment, and willingness to partner. We follow non-discriminatory practices set forth by the Equal Housing Opportunity Commission.



### The Groundbreakers' Club

The Groundbreakers' Club is for those individuals or organizations who want to pledge \$50 or more each time we break ground for a Sarpy Habitat home.

Groundbreakers' Club members become partners with us in our effort to build homes that selected families can afford. Groundbreakers' donations provide the consistent support we need to continue building Habitat homes in Sarpy County.
